Home Sharing Tips

- Home sharing works well for many but not for all.
- Take the time to learn if it's a good fit for you.
- Don't rush through the process.
- Be clear about expectations.
- Be open. People are often surprised at how much they enjoy having someone else in the home.
- Don't expect perfection and be to communicate and address issues as they arise.
